# THE NATIONAL PARKS (TRADING) REGULATIONS, 2014

### 2014, No. 9

THE NATIONAL PARKS (TRADING) REGULATIONS made in exercise of the powers contained in section 26 of the National Parks Act, Cap. 290.

#### 1. Short title

These Regulations may be cited as the National Parks (Trading) Regulations, 2014.

#### 2. Interpretation

In these Regulations-

- "Act" means the National Parks Act, Cap. 290;
- "Authority" means the National Parks Authority established under section 3 of the Act;
- "Applicant" means the person who applies for a licence under Regulation 4;
- "Labour Code" means the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code Cap. 27 and any amendments thereto:
- "Licensee" means a person licensed under these Regulations to carry on business in the Park;
- "Park" has the same meaning assigned to it as in section 2 of the Act;
- "Parks Commissioner" has the same meaning assigned to it as in section 2 of the Act;

# 3. Prohibition of operating a business in the Park without a licence

A person shall not carry on any business within the Park without a licence obtained for that purpose from the Authority.

# 4. Procedure for application

- (b) any other business not specified,
- shall be made to the Parks Commissioner in the Form prescribed in Schedule I.
- (2) The Parks Commissioner shall review all applications received for a licence and submit them to the Authority with his recommendations.
- (3) The Parks Commissioner may require an applicant to submit such other information in writing as he may consider necessary.
- (4) The Authority shall consider any application submitted to it and if satisfied approve the grant of a licence to the applicant.

#### 5. Grant of licence and licence fee

- (1) The class of licences in relation to the carrying on of business in the Park are as specified in Schedule II.
- (2) Where an application for a licence is approved by the Authority, the applicant in whose favour the application was approved shall be informed by the Authority and upon payment of—
  - (a) the prescribed fee set out in Schedule II; or
  - (b) the fee determined by the Authority in the case of an unspecified business,
- the Parks Commissioner shall issue to the applicant a licence in the Form set out in Schedule III
- (3) Any licence granted under these Regulations shall be subject to such conditions as the Authority may think fit.
  - (4) The Authority shall keep a register in which there is recorded—
    - (a) the number of the licence;
    - (b) the name and address of each licensee;
    - (c) the type of business the licensee is authorized to carry on;
    - (d) the address and location at which the business is to be carried on; and
    - (e) the period during which the licence is valid.

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#### 6. Duration and renewal of licence

- (1) A licence under these Regulations shall remain in force for 1 year from the date on which it was issued unless sooner revoked by the Authority under regulation 8.
- (2) The holder of a licence, which expires in accordance with sub-regulation (1), may apply to the Parks Commissioner for the renewal of the licence 30 days prior to its expiration date.
- (3) A class C licence granted for the purpose of carrying on business in the Park for a special event shall be valid only for the period identified in the licence and sub paragraphs (1) and (2) above shall not apply thereto.

#### 7. Scope and conditions of licence

- (1) A licensee shall not carry on business in the Park which he is not authorized to conduct under the licence.
- (2) No licence granted under these Regulations shall authorize the licensee to conduct any business for which a licence is required by any other law for the time being in force in Antigua and Barbuda.
- (3) The grant of a licence under these Regulations does not authorize the licensee to erect any structure within any Park. Any person who wishes to erect a structure within any area of the Park shall with the written consent of the Authority obtain the approval of the Development Control Authority.
  - (4) A licence issued under these Regulations shall-
    - (i) not be transferable.
    - (ii) be subject to such conditions as may be imposed or specified therein.
- (5) A copy of the licence granted under this regulation shall be displayed in a conspicuous place in the public part of the business premises in the Park.

#### 8. Revocation of licence

The Authority may revoke any licence granted under these Regulations where a licensee

- (c) has been convicted of an offence outside of Antigua and Barbuda which is punishable in Antigua & Barbuda on indictment;
- (d) carries on business not authorized by the licence;
- (e) indulges in harassment of patrons, other licensees or conducts himself in a disorderly manner as to make him unfit to carry on business in the Park;
- (f) has become incapable of carrying on the business in respect of which the license was issued.
- (g) permits someone to work without a valid work permit.

## 9. Right of a licensee to be heard

No licence shall be revoked under these Regulations unless the licensee is first given notice of the intent to revoke the licence and an opportunity to give reasons, within the time specified in the notice, why the licence should not be revoked.

#### 10. Appeals

- (1) There is hereby established an Appeal Tribunal for the purpose of hearing and determining appeals referred to it under these Regulations.
- (2) The Tribunal shall be appointed by the Minister with responsibility for the National Parks and shall consist of:
  - (a) a Chairperson, who shall be a legal practitioner;
  - (b) a person with no less than 7 years experience in the marine industry;
  - (c) a person with knowledge and experience in environmental matters;
  - (d) a person from the community in which the National Park is located.
- (3) A member of the tribunal shall hold office for a period not exceeding two years but shall be eligible for reappointment upon the expiry of any such period.
  - (4) The names of all member of the Tribunal as first constituted and every change in the member-

- (6) The secretary shall keep a written record of all proceedings of the Tribunal which shall be confirmed by the Chairman.
- (7) The decisions of the Tribunal shall be by a majority of votes of members present and voting and in addition to an original vote, the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote in any case in which the voting is equal.
- (8) A member of the Tribunal who is in any way directly or indirectly interested in a matter coming before the Tribunal shall declare the nature of his or her interest in the matter as soon as it is practicable to do so, and shall take no part directly or indirectly in any deliberation, discussion, consideration or similar activity by the Tribunal on that matter.

#### 11. Prohibited Persons

The Parks Commissioner shall not accept any application for a licence and the Authority shall not consider or approve any application for a licence or renewal of a licence under these Regulations if—

- (a) the applicant's licence has been previously revoked
  - (i) under regulation 8, paragraphs (a),(d),(e) or (f) unless two years have elapsed since its revocation;
  - (ii) under regulation 8, paragraphs (b) or (c) unless five years have elapsed since its revocation.
- (b) the applicant is—
  - (i) an individual or partnership who is not a citizen of Antigua and Barbuda, nor in possession of a valid work permit issued under the Labour Code;
  - (ii) a company which is not incorporated under the laws of Antigua and Barbuda nor registered as an external company and in possession of registration number issued by the Commissioner of Inland Revenue.

# 12. Recovery of unpaid fees

Any fees which remain unpaid after the expiration of one month after they become due and payable under these Regulations may be recovered in civil proceedings before any court.

two thousand dollars (\$2000.00) or to imprisonment not exceeding three months, and in the case of a continuing offence is liable to a further penalty of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each day during which the offence continues.

- (2) Where a body corporate commits an offence under subparagraph (1), in addition to the penalties thereunder, every director thereof is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) or to imprisonment not exceeding six months and in the case of a continuing offence is liable to a further penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each day during which the offence continues unless he adduces evidence to show that the offence was committed without his knowledge, consent or connivance.
- (3) The Magistrate may, in addition to any fine imposed under this Regulation, make such Order as he thinks fit, including an Order for the closure of the business and eviction of the person from the Park.
